

Electric Irons

Irons are used to iron clothes, sheets, and curtains. Electric irons have temperature settings: hot, warm, cool, and permanent press.

Some clothes are permanent press and require only a light touch up with a warm iron. Others are made from materials that wrinkle easily and need to be pressed with a hot iron.

Most irons use steam to get stubborn wrinkles out. Some irons also have a spray button so clothes can be dampened. Damp clothes iron better and quicker.

Spray starch can be used to create a crisp look. Starch can be light, medium, or heavy.
