\text { month }>\text { day }(,)>\text { year }
$$

Remember to put a comma (,) between the day and the year. Putting a comma between the day and the year keeps the numbers separate.

A. Rewrite the following dates. Add a comma between the day and year. *Note: Remember to capitalize the months. Example: January 20, 2007

B. Dates can be written using only numbers. There are 12 months in a year and each month has a number. July 4, 1996 is the same as $7-4-96$ or $7 / 4 / 96$.
