Four Seasons

There are four seasons in a year: winter, spring, summer, and fall. Fall is also called autumn. Each



season is three months long.

The coldest season is winter, and the hottest season is summer. Winter starts in December, spring starts in March, summer starts in June, and fall starts in September.

Most calendars have labels to indicate the first day of a new season. The seasons repeat year after year. The weather changes each season.
