Buses are large vehicles that carry many people.

People on the bus are called *passengers*.



Public Bus

Passengers pay a fare when they get on the bus. They can pay with cash but they need to have the exact fare. The bus driver does not give change. Passengers can also buy bus passes or pay with their phones.

Bus fares tend to be affordable. It is cheaper to take the bus than to buy a car.

In large cities some buses run every fifteen minutes. In small cities the buses usually run every hour. Buses run at night in large cities but not in smaller ones. Most public buses do not run on major holidays like Thanksgiving or Christmas.
